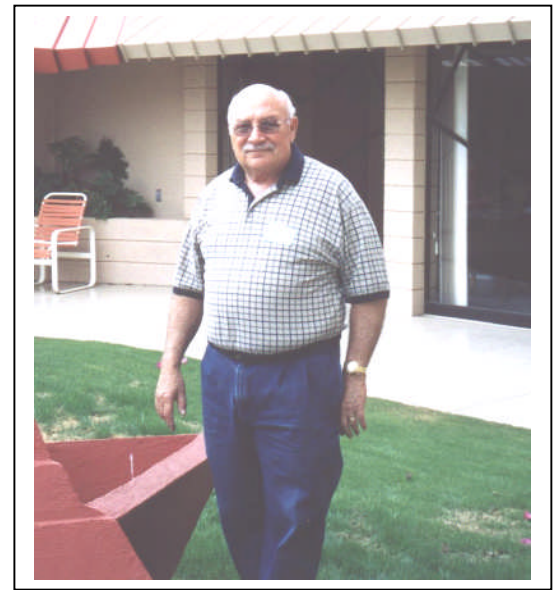


Arizona License Plate Society MEMBER SPOTLIGHT
