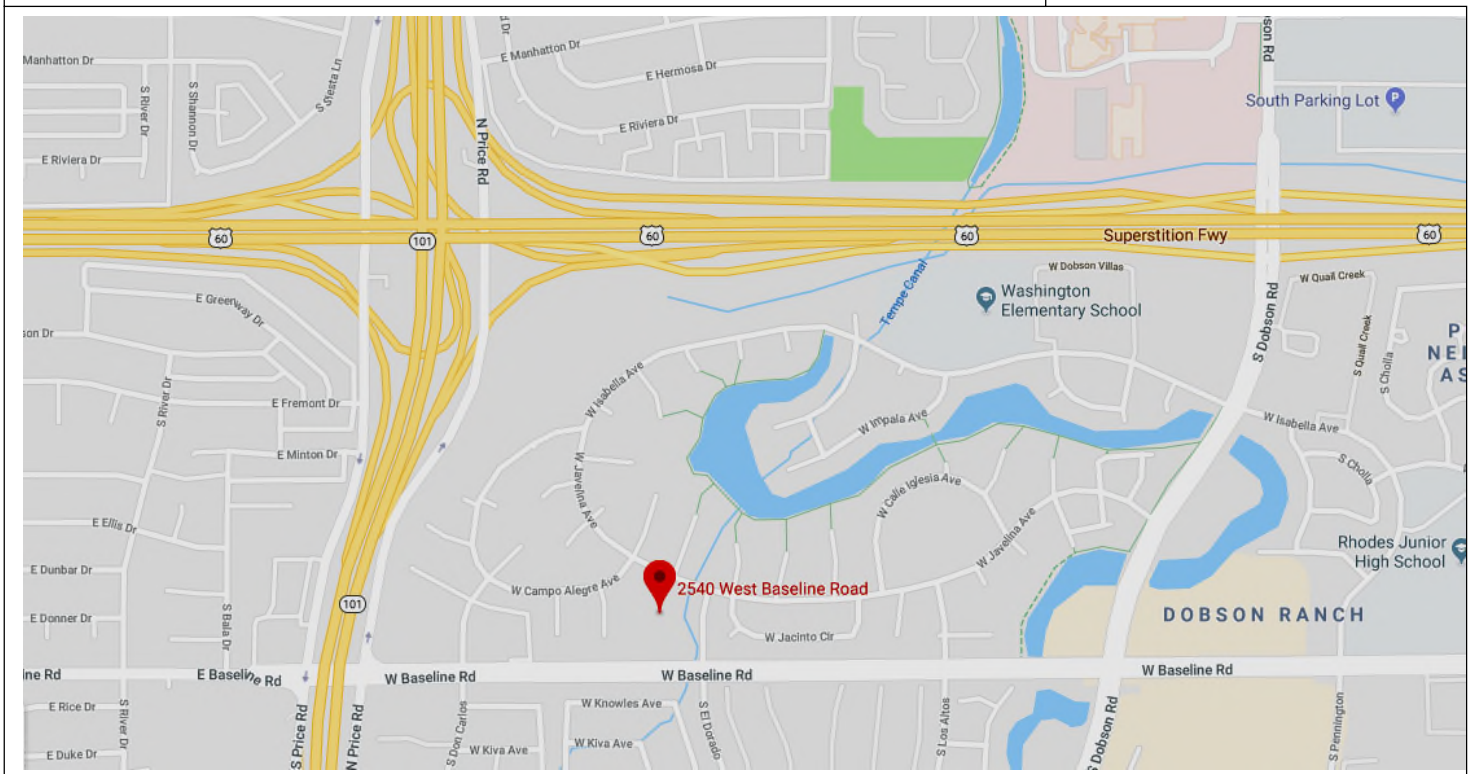
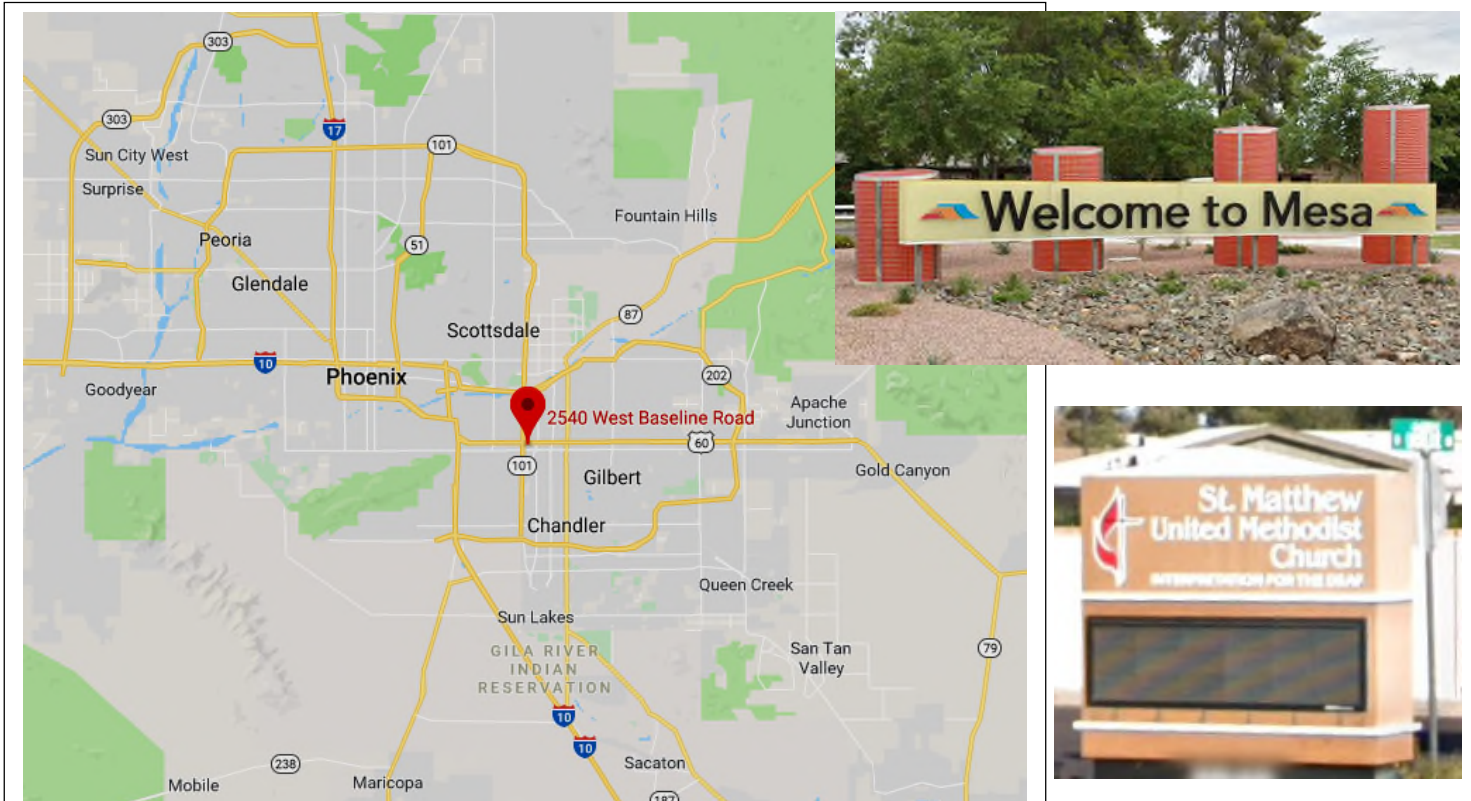

- If Southbound on Loop 101 – Exit 54 Baseline Road and turn left on Baseline
- If Northbound on Loop 101 – Exit 55C Baseline Road and turn right on Baseline.
- If Eastbound on US 60 - Exit 177 Dobson Road and turn right on Dobson, then right on Baseline
- If Westbound on US 60 – Exit 177 Dobson Road and turn left on Dobson (over the freeway), then right on Baseline

St Matthew United Methodist Church is on the corner of El Dorado and Baseline. Park in the back lot or along the street.



# ALPS Club Museum Project Update!

It has been an exciting couple of months since we provided our latest update with our August meet flyer. The response and excitement about the project has been awesome! This is a project ALPS has been working on to assemble a complete run of Arizona License Plates to display to the public at museums and public venues in Arizona.

## Here is an update on this project:

We had several bids and checks sent from our members in Arizona and beyond. At our August meet, several members bid (and outbid) on the plates available for sponsorship. In addition, we had generous club project earmarked donations from Jim Fox, John Degrafft, Dan Steele, and Bill Kraul. Our friend and former member Vince Dimiceli passed away in 2017 – and his name will belong to the 2017 plate on the project due to his past support of this project.

If you would like to bid, you can do so up until the ALPS Meet on November 23, 2019. The bid sheets will be available at both the Sept 28 meet in Mesa and the November 23 meet in Maricopa. We can also take bids by mail and by email. **NO MONEY IS DUE UNTIL BIDDING IS COMPLETE AND THE WINNERS ARE IDENTIFIED.** We of course also accept straight donations of money or plates for this cause if you are not interested in a sponsorship but would like to help the cause.

The winning bids will be announced after lunch at the ALPS business meeting at the Nov 23 meet in Maricopa. The winners will have their name featured as the 'sponsor' of the plate when the final project is displayed in a museum. As a reminder, we already have the license plates for the display, all purchased with ALPS Club Project donation money. Most plates in this collection were donated by someone over the years, but for the first time in years the opportunity is open again to be part of this project.
